
## What are the parking options at the venue?

the venue rules

#### **Event Time Restrictions**

Guests must adhere to the designated event time from 10:00 AM to 10:00PM. Staying beyond this time without prior arrangement may incur additional fees.

#### **Behavior**

Rude or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated. The venue reserves the right to ask anyone exhibiting such behavior to leave, and in extreme cases, cancel the event.

#### **Restricted Areas**

Certain areas, such as the east end of the grounds near the pond, are off-limits after dusk.

#### **Alcohol Consumption**

Guests are responsible for their own alcohol consumption. Service of alcohol to minors is strictly prohibited.

#### Smoking

Smoking is allowed only in designated areas. Failure to comply may result in a cleaning fee.

#### Pets


